## Approved alternative way (to complying with the Poisons Standard, Part 2) of labelling a package containing a medicine (labelling exemption)

## Medicines and Poisons (Medicines) Regulation 2021 - section 237

I, Gregory Perry, Director, Medicines Approvals and Regulation Unit and delegate of the Chief Executive, Queensland Health, do hereby approve the following alternative way of labelling a package containing a medicine.

## **The Alternative Way**

In Queensland, the products in Table 1 which are labelled as an unscheduled product can be supplied by Sanofi-Aventis Healthcare Pty Ltd trading as Sanofi Consumer Healthcare Pty Ltd, as a Schedule 2 medicine.

Table 1: Product to which label exemption applies:

ARTG ID	Description
155405	Bisacodyl 5mg products in pack size 50, 80, 200 tablets for constipation

## **Conditions of approval**

- 1. The medicines in Table 1 must only be supplied by wholesale to a pharmacy for retail sale. No sales outside a pharmacy must occur.
- 2. Retail supply is to be from pharmacies only and the incorrectly labelled products must be stored in pharmacies as Schedule 2 products.
- 3. This approval is effective from 01 February 2025.
- 4. This approval expires on 10 March 2025 or until existing stock of the products in Table 1 without labelling that complies with the Poisons Standard are exhausted, whichever is the earlier.
