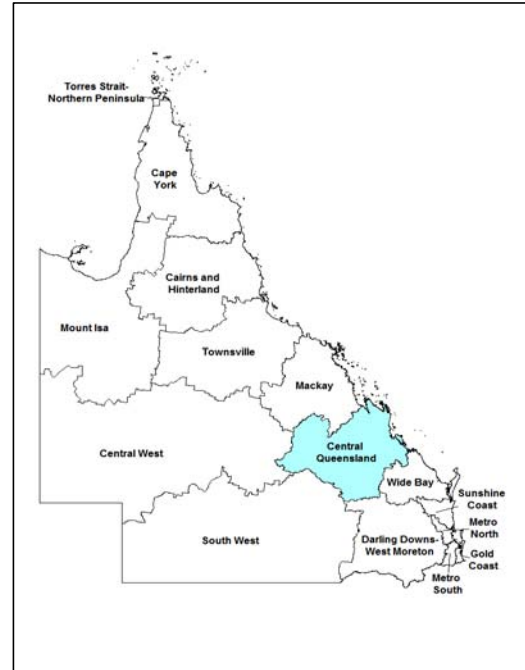


Central Queensland HSD - Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Population Profile 2006
