Electrical contractors licence allowance

Human Resources Policy C79 (QH-POL-983)

Purpose

To outline the entitlements payable to an employee who is included on the Queensland Health Electrical Contractor Licence as a qualified technical person (QTP) and/or a qualified business person (QBP).

Application

This policy applies to eligible Queensland Health and Hospital and Health Service (HHS) employees.

Policy

1 Principles

A Queensland Health or HHS employee who is:

- included on the Queensland Health Electrical Contractors Licence as a qualified technical person (QTP) and/or a qualified business person (QBP); and
- required to perform the function of QTP and/or QBP as part of their role; and
- performing the function of QTP and/or QBP

will be paid an all-purpose allowance of \$79.80 per week for each function they perform.

As an employer, Queensland Health has an obligation under the Work Health and Safety Act 2011 to manage risks to employees arising through our work, work environments, systems and practices. When applying this policy, proper consideration must be given to the Managing the risk of psychosocial hazards at work Code of Practice 2022, including identifying psychosocial hazards and assessing and managing any risks.

Qualified technical person (QTP)	Has the same meaning as under section 7 of the <i>Electrical Safety Regulation</i> 2013.
