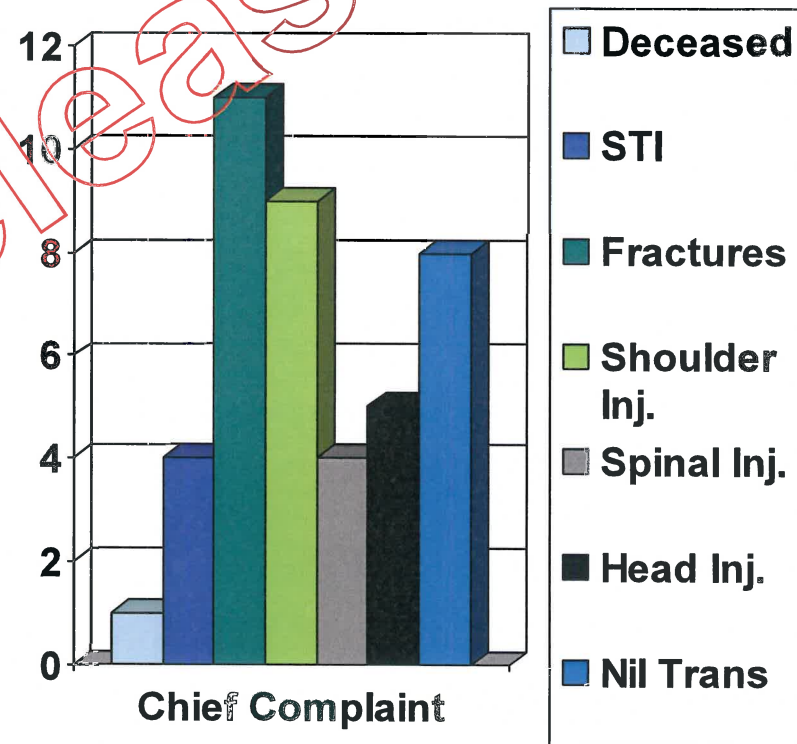

# Rider Killed Successful jumps end in final tragedy

A 35-year-old motocross rider made his final jump at the Black Duck Valley 4WD Park, south of Gatton, plunging instantly to his death on Saturday afternoon.

Police yesterday said the man suffered critical injuries and died at the scene after being thrown from his machine about 2.30pm. The man's name and other details of his identity had not been released by late yesterday.

Witnesses said the man practised jumping from the five-metre-high quad ramp several times without fault before the doomed final attempt.

Park owner Greg Diets is certain human error, not track design, was the cause of the fatal accident.

"The fellow went over and over

about four or five times and was doing it perfect, every time was sweet," Mr Diets said. "For some reason (on the last) he dived, which indicates to me motor stalled."

Mr Diets's son tried to rescue the rider and called an ambulance, but the man was believed dead instantly with multiple head injuries.

In January, bike error was found to be the cause of another fatal accident at the park.

Mr Diets said the quad ramp which last night featured on *Gutierrez Book of World Record* jump attempted by Jamie Bar of Cecil Plains, was the biggest of its kind in Australia.

The track leading up to and including the ramp, he said, was 330ft which was "just extreme safety".

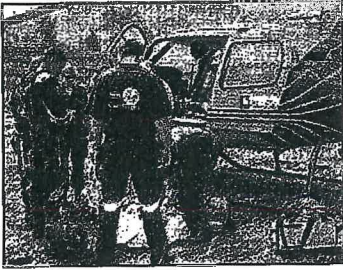

## Boy airlifted after bike accident at Black Duck

A BRISBANE teenager is in Toowoomba Hospital with suspected spinal injuries after a trail-bike accident at Black Duck Valley, 46km south of Gatton.

An RACQ CareFlight helicopter flew the 13-year-old boy to the hospital after he fell off his bike at the popular 4WD and motorbike park.

Queensland Ambulance Service Gatton was called to the scene about 11.43am yesterday before the helicopter arrived.

The teenager, of Closeburn on the north-west outskirts of Brisbane, is in a stable condition.

The incident follows three fatal accidents at Black Duck Valley since January 2005.

A 23-year-old man Bribie Island man was killed there on January 16 this year after his 4WD plunged down a steep slope while travelling along a track at the recreational park.

On June 26, 2005, a man died of critical injuries after being thrown from his motorbike while riding on a course at the park.

Only six months earlier, a man was killed when thrown from his quad-bike while riding the novice track.

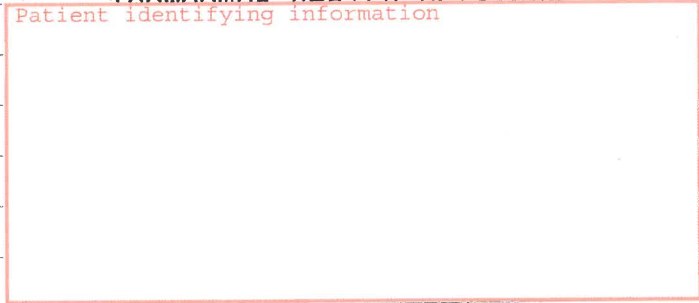

# Black day for teenage driver

A PACIFIC Pines teenager has paid severely for drink-driving on a provisional licence and driving dangerously at the Black Duck Valley 4WD Park near Gatton. Steven James McGuirly, 17, pleaded guilty in Gatton Magistrates Court to drink-driving and driving without due care and atten-

tion. Prosecutor Sergeant Bill McKenzie said the manager of Black Duck Valley 4WD Park saw McGuirly driving a four-wheel-drive erratically some hundreds of metres from the reception centre at 8.45pm on July 28. The tyres were spinning, the vehicle was sliding, stopping and starting, and McGuirly was driving with the lights off for some dis-

tance, the court was told. This was repeated over and over along the gravel road. Police attended and questioned McGuirly, but he denied the allegations. Sergeant McKenzie said police then breath-tested McGuirly and found he had a blood-alcohol concentration of 0.134%. This was treated seriously as he only held a provisional licence

which requires a zero reading at all times. McGuirly's solicitor Andrew Moloney (Ryan and Bosscher Lawyers) said his client had learnt his lesson on the importance of holding a licence, as he had been without one since the incident. Magistrate Bruce Schemioneck said it was a serious matter as McGuirly was on his provisional licence and should have had no

alcohol at all in his system. Mr Schemioneck convicted and fined McGuirly \$1500. McGuirly also was disqualified from holding a driver's licence for three months. The conviction was recorded. After handing down his sentence, Mr Schemioneck warned McGuirly of the dangers of young people, drink-driving and driving dangerously. "That type of mix kills people," he said.

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A BOY, 12, was injured in a motorcycle accident at Black Duck Valley yesterday on the day of a coronial inquest into the controversial bike and four-wheel-drive park.

# Rider breaks leg at Black Duck park

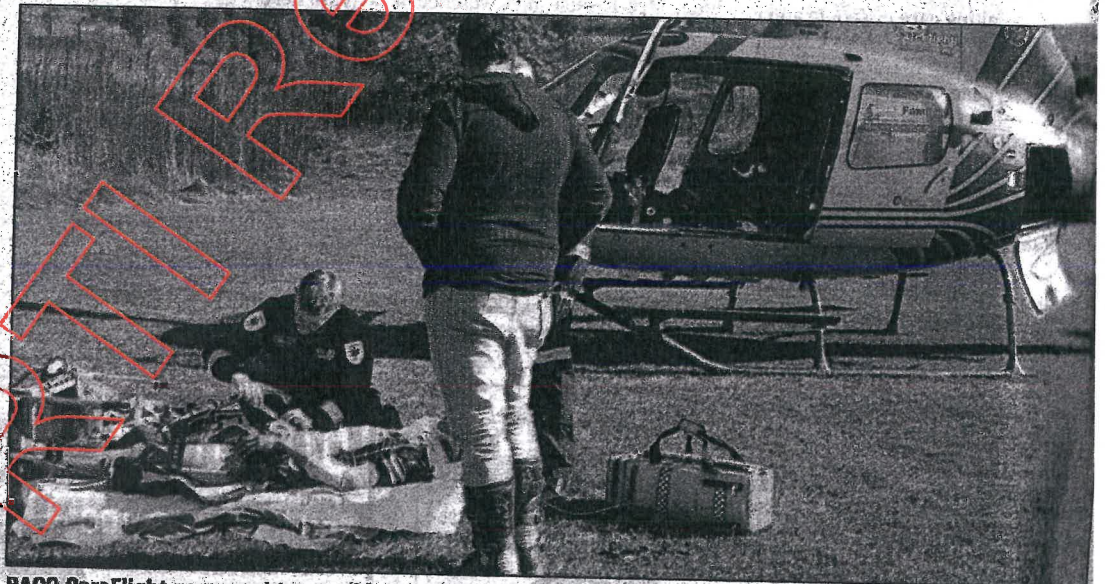
Queensland Ambulance Service said a 20-year-old motocross rider from the Sunshine Coast had suffered a broken leg after coming off the motorcycle he had been riding on one of the park's notorious tracks.

It is believed the man fell from the bike at one of the course's motorcycle jumps about 1pm Saturday.

He was airlifted to Toowoomba Hospital by RACQ CareFlight with a fractured left femur (thighbone).

The man had been stabilised by the CareFlight medical crew at the scene before being flown out.

His injuries were not considered serious and it is believed he was in a satisfactory condition last night.

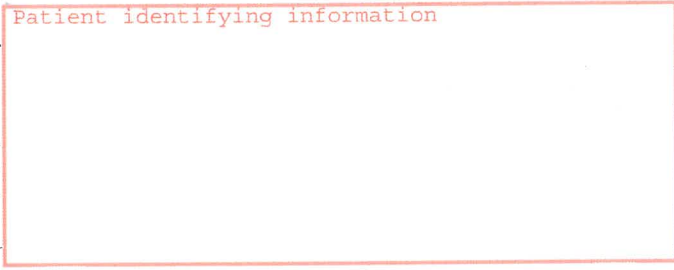

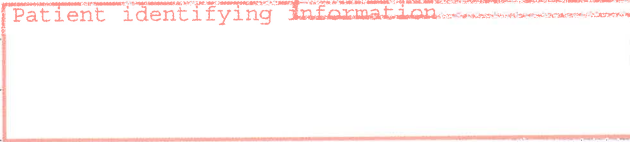
